Chromebooks will be coming home with your students at the end of the day today in order for them to participate in eLearning instruction. Instructions for eLearning will be made available via email and/or social media. Daily lessons will be posted to Google Classroom or other approved platforms by 9:00 a.m. each day. Teachers will be available online between the hours of 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. and 1:00 to 3:00 p.m. each week day to assist students. We will supply a list of free internet hotspots for those without service. If you are unable to connect to the internet, please contact your student's school for alternative learning materials.

Please continue to follow the proper hygiene practices including:

- Wash your hands often with soap and water, especially after you cough or sneeze. Alcohol-based hand cleaners are also effective.
- Cover your nose and mouth with a tissue when you cough or sneeze. Throw the tissue in the trash after you use it.
- Cough or sneeze into your sleeve, rather than your hands, if a tissue is not available.
- Try to avoid close contact with sick people.
- If you get sick, stay home from work or school and limit contact with others.
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose or mouth. Germs spread that way.
- If you develop flu-like symptoms, call your healthcare provider to determine next steps for care.

We will be deep cleaning and disinfecting our facilities and school buses during this time to prepare for a healthy return to education. Thank you in advance for your understanding and flexibility during these uncharted times.
