Clayton Beard thanked Mr. Sheffer for going above and beyond with countless hours put into consideration of the hybrid schedule.

Gina Hackman thanked the high school staff for their efforts on the hybrid schedule.

Gina Hackman commended Mr. McClure and the BCMS staff on the seamless transition to the cohort schedule.

Mary Lou Burcham thanked BCCHS and BCMS staff members for the hours spent on the hybrid (BCCHS) and cohort (BCMS) schedules.
