Members of the Board of School Trustees of the Brownstown Central Community School Corporation met on Monday, May 2, 2022 at 5:30 p.m. at Brownstown Central Administration Office, 608 West Commerce Street, Brownstown, IN 47220 to discuss representation on the school board of trustees.

President Scott Shade called the meeting to order. Brian Wheeler led the Pledge of Allegiance, and a moment of silence was observed.

Roll call was taken by President Scott Shade. Members David Martin, Gina Hackman, Mary Lou Burcham, Paul Borden and Brian Wheeler were present, as were Superintendent Tim Taylor, Assistant Superintendent Jade Peters, Melissa Hogan, several patrons, and 1 member of the media. Member Clayton Beard Arrived at a later time.

Scott Shade spoke on the history of how the current representation of the district townships began, and how the rotation process is structured.

Jessica Billingsley, of Church Church Hittle & Antrim, spoke on the legal process involved to amend changes with the current township representation.

Mr. Taylor stated that BCCSC has looked at different options for future board representation of the townships, and that BCCSC wants what is best for the students and families of Brownstown school district.

Mr. Peters discussed options for board representation that are currently being looked at, and that BCCSC is open for suggestions.

Jessica Billingsley gave an overview of the legal parameters of elected school board representation verses appointed school board representation.

Several board members discussed their likes and concerns of the different board representation options that were presented by Mr. Peters.

Dave Hall, Russell Fritz, Dan Blann, Doug Nuss and Melissa Gray shared their views in regards to school board representation.

Having no other business, on a motion by Clayton Beard, seconded by Gina Hackman, the board unanimously approved to adjourn the meeting at 6:48 p.m.
